<u>April is recognized as Child Abuse Prevention Month.</u> *Spark of Hope* is an effort to promote awareness of child abuse and neglect in our community. At any given time in Hall, Hamilton, Howard, and Merrick Counties, there are up to 212 children in Foster Care. With the help of 28 volunteers, Heartland CASA served 62 children in foster care last year. Children on average spend 24 months in foster care, however, studies have shown that children who have a CASA volunteer appointed spend approximately 8 months less time in care, have fewer disruptions with their foster care placement, and have more positive behavioral and educational outcomes.
