The Catholic Churches in Grand Island are closed until June 1st. After consulting with a trusted doctor, some of you, and praying about it I have decided to wait until **June 1st** for St. Anns and Sacred Heart. I know for some this will be difficult news to hear. I know there is the theory of "let's get back to normal", at this time I cannot in good conscience open the churches up. I long to get back to "normal" and to once again have you all in the church, but I cannot let those feelings drive my decision. I have to err on the side of caution and the advice I received from the doctor that I spoke with.

**Confirmation and First Communion** are postponed. Once a date is determined, it will be announced.
