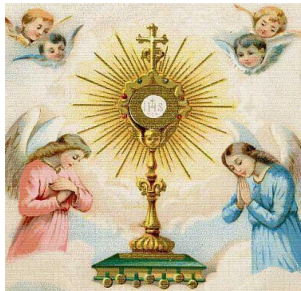

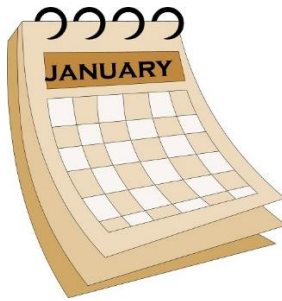

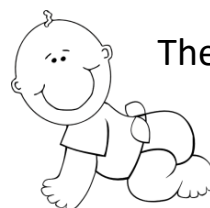


**Please pray for the seminarians and the sick parishioners of Sacred Heart and St. Ann**
