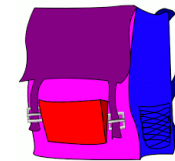
**MAGNIFICAT SUMMER PRAYER MEAL**

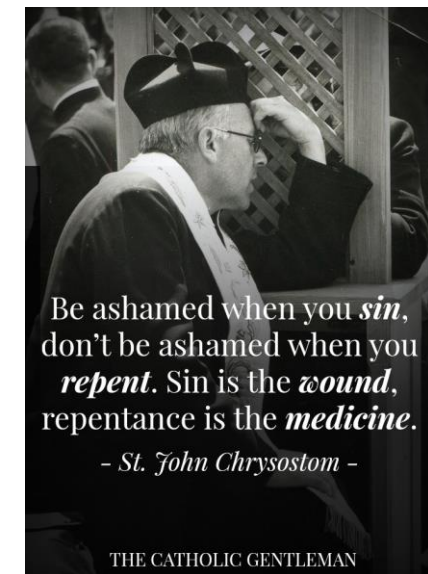
