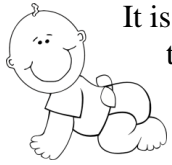

ALL SOUL'S DAY – Part III

Praying for the dead is a Christian obligation. In the modern world, when many have come to doubt the Church's teaching on Purgatory, the need for such prayers has only increased. The Church devotes the month of November to prayer for the Holy Souls in Purgatory, and participation in the Mass of All Souls Day is a good way to begin the month. All Souls' Day Mass is at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, Nov. 2nd. If you would like your loved ones remembered on All Soul's Day, please place their names on the All Soul's Day envelope mailed in your packet or on one of the envelopes in the back of church and turn in before All Soul's Day. If you would like separate Masses said as well for those listed on your envelope, you can include Mass stipends in that envelope. The regular Mass stipend in our Diocese is \$10.
