A traveling icon of "Our Lady of Czestochowa" (the "Black Madonna") will be in Lincoln, on Wednesday, June 25th. From 4:00 pm– 4:30 pm the icon will be present for an informal prayer service at Planned Parenthood's abortion facility in Lincoln (48th and Old Cheney). At 6:30 pm the icon will be at St. Joseph's Church (7900 Trendwood Dr.) in Lincoln for a welcoming ceremony and rosary followed by Mass at 7:00 pm with Fr. Peter West from Human Life International as homilist. This event is part of a pilgrimage called *Ocean to Ocean International Campaign in Defense of Life*. The pilgrimage of the icon is intended as a response to nearly a century of legalized abortion first imposed by the Soviet Union, then spread to other nations.
