# CROSS OF CONTINUED GIVING @ St. Ann's

Many of you may have noticed the Cross plaque hanging next to the Sacristy. However, you may not be aware of the significance of the plaque. Father Kurz started the Cross of Continued Giving while he was here. The Cross plaque has to do with that. So, what is the Cross of Continued Giving? If you would like to give a

donation in memory of your loved one that has passed (minimum of \$500), that money will go into the Cross of Continued Giving fund, and your loved one's name will go on the plaque. The fund must maintain a minimum balance of \$5,000. Anything above the \$5,000 can be requested to be used for a project towards repairing or improving something that has to do with the Church building. Funds can only be accessed once per year.
